RESOLUTION 3-20 -A

A RESOLUTION TO RATIFY AND EXTEND MAYOR'S PROCLAMATION OF DISASTER EMERGENCY OF MARCH 16, 2020 TO REMAIN IN EFFECT UNTIL THE COMMONWEALTH DISASTER DECLARATION FOR DELAWARE COUNTY MUNICIPALITIES ENDS OR OTHERWISE CANCELLED BY OFFICIAL ACTION BY COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Mayor may issue a Proclamation when he considers that a state of emergency exists pursuant to Section 10A06 (b) (4) of the Borough Code for a period not to exceed seven (7) days or extended by resolution of Council; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Mayor executed a Proclamation of Disaster Emergency on March 16, 2020 due to the imminent disaster and emergency throughout the Commonwealth posed by COVID -19; and

WHEREAS, due to the ongoing and present danger throughout the Commonwealth posed by COVID -19; Council ratifies the Proclamation and believes an extension of the period of seven (7) days for the Proclamation of Emergency Disaster is necessary to allow the Borough's Emergency Coordinator ("EMC") and Borough Council President to continue to operate under the Emergency Operation Plan ("EOP") and to protect the health, welfare and safety of the Borough's residents and public in general; and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Borough of Chester Heights, Delaware County, the *Proclamation of Disaster Emergency* executed by the Mayor on March 16, 2020 is hereby ratified and extended to coincide and remain in effect until the Commonwealth Disaster Declaration related to Delaware County municipalities ends or is hereby otherwise cancelled by official action of Council.
