

MINUTES OF THE FOURTEENTH MONTHLY MEETING
OF THE BOROUGH OF CHESTER HEIGHTS, PA. COUNCIL
HELD IN THE SCHOOL BLDG. MONDAY,
FEBRUARY 3rd. 1947, at 8 P.M.

The President of Council, J. Taney Willcox called this meeting to order at 8 P.M. All members of Council were present except mr. Stromgren.

The Minutes of the January 6th. 1947 meeting were read by the Secretary and unanimously approved.

A motion was made, seconded and unanimously RESOLVED that the Highway Committee be authorized to expend not over \$250.00 for the purchase and creation of the necessary 35 M.P.H. speed limit signs as authorized.

103 Mrs. Sadie R. Kerns, Pres. Board of Health recommended this work be turned over to the State in order to save the Borough the cost of operating its own Health Dept. which would be at least \$200.00 for the first year. The following RESOLUTION

was offered and unanimously approved.

RESOLVED that the Borough of Chester Heights hereby surrenders all of its rights to control Board of Health affairs to the Pennsylvania Board of Health at Harrisburg; that the Borough is in no position financially to maintain its own Health Department and the Borough further waives all responsibilities therefrom to the Pennsylvania Department of Health and the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

On behalf of Council the President, J. Taney Willcox extended thanks to Mrs. Kerns and the Health Committee for their work during the past year and discharged this committee.

Next in order was presented by Solicitor, Donald H. Hamilton a Financial Statement of Assets & Liabilities from Aston Twsp. which was referred to the Finance Committee for recommendations.

The matter of Garbage collection came up for discussion and was turned over to the Burgess for investigation and recommendation regarding the choice of the residents as to garbage collections and trash collections. The Burgess is to report to Council on this matter at the March 1947 meeting.

Next order of business was a Report of the ^{Finance} ~~Budgett~~ Committee. After lengthy discussion Council unanimously

104 RESOLVED, that the Budgett as presented be tentatively approved and when prepared for publication it be published in one issue of the "Rockdale Herald" giving notice of the fact the Budgett will be available for public inspection at the office of the Borough Secretary.
