

MINUTES OF THE TWENTY-EIGHTH MONTHLY MEETING
 OF THE BOROUGH OF CHESTER HEIGHTS, PA. COUNCIL
 HELD IN THE BOROUGH SCHOOL BLDG. MONDAY
 APRIL 5th. 1948 at 8 P.M.

This meeting was called to order at 8 P.M. with all members of Council present except Mr. Keller and Mr. Stromgren.

The minutes of the March 1st. meeting were read by the Secretary and unanimously approved with the exception that the report of the Treasurer, which was overlooked, be inserted into the minutes of the March 1st. 1948 meeting.

Upon the Secretary presenting bills to Council for approval there was some discussion over a bill presented by Street Commissioner John S. Voigt for 7 hrs. labor on the roads @ \$1.00 per hour to be paid to hired laborers, it being contended by some that hired labor should not be paid at the same hourly rate as is paid to the Street Commissioner. After discussion a motion was made and seconded to pay for all labor on the roads at the rate of \$1.00 per hour. This motion was carried with one negative vote.

The following bills were then presented to Council by the Secretary and were unanimously approved.

The next business before Council was the report of the Treasurer, Mrs. Josephine G. Breneman which was read and unanimously approved.

J of P. Buckley reported that cars are being parked on both sides of the road at the foot of Lenni hill thereby narrowing the passage to a point of danger. Council recommended this matter be taken up with the Highway Dep't. of the state for solution.

Mr. Buckley also recommended a pipe line for water be laid

from the creek to the center of Chester Height. This subject involved so many questions and so far reaching in scope that the Fire Marshal, Mr. Kern was requested to investigate the entire water problem and report to Council. Also Mr. Hamilton was requested to investigate the possibilities of tapping into the Chester Water Co's. project from the Octoraro Creek.

Councilman, Herbert H. Breneman submitted an analysis, he had made of the questionnaire sent to all Tax payers and Voters within the Borough. He recommended this analysis be made the subject of the "Borough News" for April with no further comment other than an introductory paragraph.

There being no further business it was moved, seconded and un-animously resolved to adjourn.
