

MINUTES OF THE TWENTY-NINTH MONTHLY MEETING
OF THE BOROUGH OF CHESTER HEIGHTS, PA. COUNCIL
HELD IN THE BOROUGH SCHOOL BLDG. MONDAY
MAY 3rd. 1948 at 8 P.M.

All Councilmen present when this meeting was called to order by President, J. Taney Willcox at 8 P.M.

The minutes of the April 5th. meeting were read by the Secretary and unanimously approved.

The Police Report of Chief of Police, John S. Voigt was read to Council also the report of Constable Chas. G. McCann. These reports were the marked for file.

A letter from the Dep't. of Revenue re. the Auditors, Financial Report was then presented to Council who directed a letter be sent to each Auditor by the Secretary, directing that this matter be disposed of without further delay.

The Secretary next reported on the "Borough News" stating that when Mrs. Frances Voigt had completed one page of the April issue the duplicating machine broke down and she was therefore unable to finish the job.

Fire Marshal, Lohr H. Kerns reported progress upon his survey of fire protection for the Borough.
