

MINUTES OF THE THIRTIETH MONTHLY MEETING
OF THE CHESTER HEIGHTS, PA. COUNCIL
HELD IN THE BOROUGH SCHOOL BLDG. MONDAY
JUNE 7th. 1948 at 8 P.M.

Councilman Stromgren was the only absentee when this meeting was called to order by the President of Council, J. Taney Willcox.

The minutes of the ~~July~~^{MAY} meeting were read by the Secretary and unanimously approved as read.

The following ~~bid~~^{BILL} was then presented by the Secretary and unanimously approved for payment.

John S. Voigt - Order No. 222 - for labor on roads - \$4.00

The letter to Donald H. Hamilton, Esq. from Mr. Peter DeAugustine regarding the Frank Hennessey property was read to Council and the Secretary was directed to note this fact in the minutes and to place the report from the Dep't. of Health on file.

A letter from Mr. Pension, Sup't. Dep't. of Highways, Media, Pa. to Mr. Hamilton re. Borough responsibility for certain road conditions was read to Council who requested Mr. Hamilton investigate this matter and report further.

Mrs. Josephine G. Breneman, Treasurer made her usual concise all inclusive Treasurers Report which was unanimously approved by Council as read.

The following drafts were reported to Council by the Secretary and turned over to the Treasurer for deposit.

The next order of business was a motion which was seconded and unanimously RESOLVED the School District of the Borough of Chester Heights be paid \$300.00 for the use of the School for monthly Council meetings to cover, Light, Heat, Water and rent and that this item be

charged against Item #14 under Borough Building or Offices.

The need of a Duplicating Machine for Borough use in getting out the Borough News and other publications was presented to Council and the Secretary was requested to inquire into the costs and merits of a machine to answer the Borough requirements.

For lack of a Duplicating Machine with which to get out the Borough News, Councilman Breneman volunteered to get the June issue out thru his own personal resources.

J of P Buckley, advocated siren equipment be placed upon the cars of the Police Officers, it was therefore moved, seconded and unanimously RESOLVED. The Burgess purchase the necessary siren equipment.

Mr. Driesbach advocated to Council that speed limit signs be placed on Elam Road. This matter was then referred by Council to the Burgess and the Borough Solicitor for the necessary application to the Dep't. of Highways.

Councilman Lohr H. Kerns in his capacity as Borough Fire Marshal asked for an appropriation of \$100.00 to be paid to The Chester Heights Volunteer Fire Co., No.1 for the purchase and installation of 2½" pipe at four strategic locations to serve as Fire Plugs for the purpose of affording quick access to water to re-fill the booster-tanks of fire apparatus.

It was moved seconded and unanimously RESOLVED \$100.00 be donated to the Chester Heights Vo. Fire Co. No. 1 for the installation of 4 Fire Plugs and the donation to be charged against Item No. 18 under Protection to Persons and Property and \$100.00 be found in some other account to replace this withdrawal.

There being no further business to come before Council it was moved, seconded and unanimously RESOLVED to adjourn.
