

MINUTES OF THE 35th. MONTHLY MEETING  
OF THE BOROUGH OF CHESTER HEIGHTS, PA. COUNCIL  
HELD IN THE BOROUGH SCHOOL BLDG. MONDAY  
NOVEMBER 1st. 1948 at 8 P.M.

This meeting was called to order by the President with all members of Council present except Mr. Kerns.

The minutes of the October meeting were read by the Secretary and unanimously approved.

The following bills were presented to Council and unanimously approved.

The next order of business was the reading of various communications received by the Secretary during the preceding 30 days among which was one from Mr. Hamilton concerning the Boroughs responsibility for cleaning of roads etc. Mr. Hamilton read an opinion he had prepared on this subject which was subsequently turned over to the Secretary to be placed on file. Council moved, seconded and unanimously RESOLVED the opinion presented by the Borough Solicitor be placed on file and the matter allowed to rest until and if events require further action.

It was further Moved, seconded and unanimously RESOLVED the question of a lump sum settlement of delinquent taxes due the Township of Aston and the Borough of Chester Heights be taken up by Mr. Hamilton with the authority to settle this matter.

Mr. Hamilton explained the permit granted John G. Moe for the operation of a bus line thru the Borough of Chester Heights.

Mrs. Josephine Breneman, Treasurer read her monthly report which was unanimously approved.

The Burgess was called upon, who had no report to submit at this time.

Constable <sup>CHARLES</sup> ~~John~~ G. McCann in his report inquired about the

authorization of a siren for his car. (This matter was suggested a few months ago but no official action was taken, pending a complete review of the police requirements of the Borough which are still under investigation.)

Justice of the Peace, Buckley had no report to make.

Chief of Police, John S. Voigt read his report which was unanimously approved and filed with the Secretary.

Mr. Jobson reported the Taylor Taxi Service failure at certain times at night to properly serve the requirements of Borough residents as required by the permit this Taxi Service was granted by the P.U.C.

Mr. Edwin Keller, Chairman of the specially appointed Police Committee reported upon the Committee's findings and recommended certain ~~pending~~ action pending suggestions of Council and a final report of this Committee.

There being no further business it was moved, seconded and un-animously Resolved to adjourn.
