

MINUTES OF THE 42nd. MONTHLY MEETING OF
THE BOROUGH OF CHESTER HEIGHTS, PA. COUNCIL
HELD IN THE BOROUGH SCHOOL BLDG.
MONDAY, JUNE 6th. 1949 at 8 P.M.

Councilman H. Herbert Breneman was unanimously chosen Chairman to preside over this meeting in the temporary absence of Council President, J. Tancy Willcox.

The minutes of the May 2nd. 1949 meeting were read and un-animously approved.

The following bills were unanimously approved for payment.

Mrs. Josephine G. Breneman, Treas. read her report which was duly unanimously approved.

Burgess, Walter E. Schrader reported the installation of a new high powered light at the intersection of Route 1 and Route 261.

The Burgess also reported discussing some practical means of improving safety conditions at the intersection of Route 1 and 261 and as a consequence of this interview suggested that Council appoint a Committee to meet with District Engineer, D.C. Stackpole for further discussion of this problem. The Secretary suggested he would be able to arrange such a meeting thru Mr. Wm. C. Canning, Engineer Director of the Keystone Automobile Club. This suggestion was ~~then~~ taken up and a Committee appointed for this meeting consisting of the permanent Highway Committee, the Burgess, Donald Hamilton and Chief of Police, John Voigt.

Chief of Police, John S. Voigt submitted his usual monthly Police Report as Aid Constable Chas. G. McCann.

Constable McCann submitted his written resignation from that office due to his moving away from Chester Heights.

It was moved, seconded and unanimously Resolved, the resignation of Chas. G. McCann be accepted with regrets.

Borough

A motion was made, and seconded that the Burgess pay the costs of a survey of the Aston Realty Co. and Elwood Rodenbok properties within the Borough of Chester Heights. This motion was passed with one negative vote, that of Councilman Krebs.

Council directed the Police Committee to consider new candidates to replace Chas. G. McGann, (resigned) .

There being no further business this meeting was adjourned by unanimous consent.
