

MINUTES OF THE 45th. MONTHLY MEETING OF
THE BOROUGH OF WESTER HIGHTS, PA. COUNCIL
HELD IN THE BOROUGH SCHOOL BLDG.
MONDAY, SEP'T. 12th. 1949 at 8 P.M.

This meeting was called to order promptly at 8 P.M. as usual by the President of Council, J. Nancy Willcox.

Dep't. of Highways there would not be any work done on Route 1 in connection with the widening of that road in the vicinity of Route 261 until the spring of 1950, but the work would be done at that time.

Tax Collector Samuel E. Jobson reported the current 1949 Taxes are coming in rather well,

The Police Committee had nothing to report.

Adjournment was in order and Councilman Krebs rose to the occasion with the necessary motion which was unanimously approved.
