additional street lights be installed within the Borough at points selected and recommended by the Burgess and that the Burgess be empowered to negotiate a contract, for so doing with the Philadelphia Electric Co.

submit her Financial Report which was read by her and unanimously

approved.

Mr. Samuel Ward, Read. of the Chester Heights Volunteer Fire

Co. No. 1 presented to Council that organizations Financial Statement for the year 1949 and estimated income and expenditures for 1950 with the result, Council accepted the statement unanimously and it was placed on file and these facts recorded in the minutes of this meeting.

A motion was made, seconded and unanimously RESOLVED the Borough pay to the Chester Heights Volunteer Fire Co. No. 1 the \$400.00 appropriated as a contribution to fire companies for the year 1950.
