

MINUTES OF THE 54th. MONTHLY MEETING OF  
THE BOROUGH OF CHESTER HEIGHTS, PA. COUNCIL  
HELD IN THE BOROUGH SCHOOL BUILDING  
MONDAY, JUNE ~~16~~<sup>15</sup>, 1950 at 8 P.M.

This meeting was again called to order by Vice President of Council H. Herbert Breneman due to the absence of President J. Taney Willcox because of illness.

The minutes of the <sup>MAY</sup> ~~June~~ meeting were read by the Secretary and unanimously approved.

It was moved, seconded and unanimously passed these bills be paid and warrants issued by the Secretary to the Treasurer.

Miscellaneous income was next reported to Council by the Secretary as was correspondence received during the past month.

The Treasurer, Mrs. Josephine G. Breneman was next called upon for her report which she read and it was unanimously approved.

Burgess, Walter Schrader continued his discussion on Delinquent Taxes and advocated that the property involved with all unpaid taxes be liened against.

It was moved, seconded and unanimously agreed that Mr. Hamilton get a letter, if possible, from the Delaware County Trust Co. on the subject of Aston Realty Co. 19~~49~~<sup>48</sup> Delq. Taxes acknowledging the tax indebtedness. If no such letter can be obtained, the question will again be brought before Council at the July meeting for further action.

Constable Chas. G. McCann had no official report to make at this meeting.

The Highway Committee had no report.

The Special Police Committee reported thru Burgess Schrader upon new street lights installed upon Borough Roads since the May meeting.

The Burgess recommended that the Borough do something about getting pipe with outlets built in and laid within the Borough by the Chester Munciple Authority when that Authority is ready to lay their pipe line.

Council moved and seconded the Burgess be appointed a Committe of one to find out steps necessary to obtain pipe outlets within the Borough.

Mr. Breneman suggested three alternates be authorized to sign Checks in absence or inability of the President, Secretary and Treasurer.

This matter was discussed but no action was taken.

It was moved, seconded and unanimously agreed to adjourn.
