

MINUTES OF THE 56th MONTHLY MEETING OF
 THE BOROUGH OF CHESTER HEIGHTS, PA. COUNCIL
 HELD IN THE BOROUGH SCHOOL BUILDING
 MONDAY, AUGUST 4TH, AT 8 P.M.

President Willcox called this meeting to order at 8 P.M.

Messrs. Keller and Kerns were absent.

The minutes of the July meeting were read and approved with

the correction inserted concerning the recommendation of the Burgess

that Council take steps to have the Chester Water Authority install at least two outlets in their pipe line for Borough use. This correction

was made in the minutes of the July meeting.

The following bills were unanimously approved for payment.

The Treasurer, Mrs. Breneman read her usual monthly report

which was unanimously approved.

Burgess Schrader recommended the new District Engineer of

the Penna. Dept. of Highways be contacted re. the recommended widening

of the Balto. Pike in the vicinity of Route 261.

It was moved, seconded and unanimously resolved that the

Borough Solicitor, Donald H. Hamilton write to the new Dist. Engineer

Mr. E.J. Kinney about this approved project in an effort to keep this

matter upon the agenda of the Highway Dept.

Burgess Walter E. Schrader also explained to Council the em-

ergency defense set-up for City's and Boroughs. His report was un-

animously approved and accepted by Council.

Regarding the Burgess recommendation that the Borough apply

for outlets in the Chester Water Authority Pipe Line it was moved,

seconded and unanimously passed that the Secretary write the Concord

Township Supervisors making the request that they apply to the Chester

Water Authority for an outlet to be installed on Elam Road for Chester

Heights use and that this Borough join with the Concord Township Supervisors in further requesting an outlet be installed wherever the pipe line crosses Borough Roads.

Chief of Police, John Voigt made a special report to Council due to unusual police activities upon Borough Roads during month of July.

The two following Resolutions were unanimously passed by Council.

RESOLVED that Anne D. Dickson be appointed Assistant Treasurer of the Borough of Chester Heights to serve until the First Monday of January 1952. The Assistant Treasurer shall perform the duties of the Treasurer in the event of illness, incapacity or absence of the Treasurer, and shall sign such checks as directed by Borough Council. Bond to be furnished in the amount of FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS. (\$5000.00)

RESOLVED that Eva N. Smitheman be appointed Assistant Secretary of the Borough of Chester Heights to serve until the First Monday of January, 1952. The Assistant Secretary shall perform the duties of the Secretary in the event of illness, incapacity or absence of the Secretary and shall sign such checks as directed by Borough Council.

Mr. Hamilton reported the Aston Realty Co. was being foreclosed and that the Borough does not need a lien to collect their delinquent taxes.

There being no further business it was moved, seconded and unanimously resolved to adjourn.
