

MINUTES OF THE 60th. MEETING OF
THE BOROUGH OF CHESTER HEIGHTS, PA. COUNCIL
HELD IN THE BOROUGH SCHOOL BUILDING
MONDAY JANUARY 8th. 1951
at 8.00 O'CLOCK P. M.

The meeting was called to order by President Willcox, at 8 P. M. All members were present, with the exception of Councilmen Stromgren and Little. The Secretary read the Minutes of the December meeting, which were unanimously approved.

Communication from Albright & Friel, Consulting Engineers for Chester Municipal Authority Water Supply, requesting permit to install a 42" water main across Mattson Road, was read. It was moved, seconded and unanimously approved that the Secretary issue the necessary Permit, in accordance with the Borough Ordinance covering the installation of such conduit.

The Treasurers Report was approved as read.

Burgess Schrader reported a Development Sign erected in the Borough, but as it was not definitely known on whose property it was erected or what the development referred to, no action was taken by Council.

The Burgess extended an invitation to all members of Council to attend a meeting of the Civil Defense Organization in the Borough School on January 15th. and also expressed his desire that all citizens of the community take a more active interest in the Civil Defense Program.

The Burgess reported on the vacancy on the Police Force and requested approval to appoint one additional Officer on a temporary basis. It was moved and seconded and unanimously approved that this request be granted and the subject referred to the Police Committee for further study.

The Burgess informed Council that an absentee member would be unable to perform his duties as a Councilman for an undetermined length of time, due to other interests. It was therefore moved and seconded and unanimously approved that the Secretary communicate with this Councilman in an effort to determine his desire to continue as a member of this Council.

There were no reports presented by the other Committees.

Due to the resignation of Hilton E. Jones, as Borough Auditor, as of Dec. 31st., it was moved and seconded and unanimously Resolved that Mrs. Elsie Wilson be appointed to fill the vacancy of Auditor.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned.
