

MINUTES OF THE 63rd. MEETING OF THE
BOROUGH OF CHESTER HEIGHTS, PA. COUNCIL HELD
IN THE BOROUGH SCHOOL BUILDING
MONDAY APRIL 2nd 1951 AT
8.00 O'CLOCK P. M.

The meeting was called to order by President Willcox.

All members were present with the exception of Councilman Stromgren.

The Treasurers Report was approved as read.

The Burgess reported on the progress being made, with the cooperation of the State Police, in an endeavor to apprehend the person suspected of causing the recent fires in the Borough.

Chief of Police, John Voigt presented his monthly report on police activities.

At the March meeting the name of Mr. G. G. Schroder was placed in nomination to fill the vacancy on the Board of Adjustments, subject to his acceptance. Mr. Schroder was present at this meeting and stated his willingness to serve. It was hereby moved, seconded and unanimously Resolved to appoint Mr. Schroder to the Board of Adjustments for the term of three years.

It was moved, seconded and unanimously approved to pay to the School Board at this time the Budget Appropriation of \$300.00 for Fuel, light and water for 1951.

A motion was made, seconded and unanimously Resolved to pay to the Chester Heights Volunteer Fire Co. #1 as a contribution for the year 1951, the Budget appropriation of \$ 400.00.

A motion was made and unanimously approved to have the Secretary communicate with the District Engineer of the Penna. Highway Dept. inquiring as to the present status of the project to remove the traffic hazard at the intersection of Routes #1 and #261.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
