

MINUTES OF THE 64th MEETING OF THE BOROUGH OF
 CHESTER HEIGHTS, PA. COUNCIL HELD IN THE BOROUGH
 SCHOOL BUILDING MONDAY MAY 7th 1951 at 8 O'CLOCK P. M.

The meeting was called to order by President Willcox.

All members were present with the exception of Councilman Keller.

A communication from Solicitor Hamilton relating to the Local Organization of Civil Defense was read. In accordance with the State Civil Defense Act, Borough Council is authorized and directed to establish a local organization of civil defense and recommend to the Governor, for appointment, a director for the local organization. It was thereby moved, seconded and unanimously approved to appoint a committee of three to select a director. President Willcox appointed Councilmen Brenneman, Krebs and Little.

A letter from the Dist. Engineer of the Highway Dept. stating he did not believe the condition at R261 and Balto. Pk. would be corrected this year was read. It was moved, seconded and unanimously approved that the Secretary write to the Highway Dept. at Harrisburg in an endeavor to obtain further definite information as to when this work would be done.

The report of the Treasurer was approved as read.

Chief of Police Voigt presented his monthly report on Police activities.

Justice of the Peace Buckley reported he was having difficulty serving warrants due to the fact the Borough was without a constable. It was moved and seconded and unanimously Resolved, that Donald H. Hamilton, Esq., the Borough Solicitor, is hereby authorized to petition the Court to appoint Samuel E. Jobson, Jr., as Constable for the Borough of Chester Heights, to fill the unexpired term of Chas. McCann.

Mr. Samuel Jobson, the Borough Tax Collector reported delinquent taxes for the year 1950 in the amount of \$242.55.

It was moved and seconded and unanimously RESOLVED, that Donald H. Hamilton, Esq. the Borough Solicitor is hereby authorized to file a lien against LANE-HALL TEXTILE CO. for delinquent taxes for the year 1950 on two premises located on Lenni Road.
