

MINUTES OF THE 65th MEETING OF THE BOROUGH OF
CHESTER HEIGHTS. PA. COUNCIL HELD IN THE BOROUGH
SCHOOL BUILDING MONDAY JUNE 4th 1951 at 8 O'CLOCK P.M.

The meeting was called to order by Pr esident Willcox.

All members were present except Councilmen Keller and Stromgren.

The Minutes of the May meeting were approved as read.

The bill from Solicitor Hamilton in the amount of \$342.50 was not approved for payment at this time. This bill which represents Legal Services rendered by the Solicitor to the Borough contains a charge of Twenty Dollars for attending the December meeting and a charge of Fifty Dollars for obtaining the appointment of the Constable, to which members of Council objected. It was unanimously approved that the Secretary communicate with Mr. Hamilton and request him to inform Council of the exact definition of what he considers normal Legal Services which he agreed to render to the Borough in return for an annual retainer fee of Two Hundred Dollars.

Correspondance from Chester Municipal Authority requesting permit to install water main across intersection of Chelsea and Bodley Rd. was read. After discussion by Burgess and members of Council on this subject it was unanimously approved for the Secretary to issue the necessary permit.

The Treasurers Report was approved as read.

The committe apointed at the May meeting to select a Director of Civil Defense reported they had not as yet arrived at a decision.

The resignation of Councilman Edwin H. Keller, effective immediatly, was read at this time. It was unanimously Resolved to accept this resignation with great regrets, as Mr. Keller has served the Borough well.

The name of Mr. Graheme Wood Jr. was placed in nomination to fill the vacancy of Councilman. It was moved and seconded and unanimously RESOLVED that Mr. Wood is hereby appointed to serve as a member of

Council of the Borough of Chester Heights for the unexpired term of Mr. Keller, which term expires the first Monday of January 1954.

Mr. Theo. Buckley brought to the attention of Council the fact that there is no Borough Ordinance whereby the Borough could retain all or part of any fines assessed against truckers who spill stone on the Highways of the Borough. The fines which are levied and collected by the Justice of Peace are paid to the State.

Mr. Buckley also suggested the Borough should enact an Ordinance to regulate parking within the Borough, particularly in the vicinity of the mills on Lenni Road where parking of vehicles on the highway presents a traffic hazard.

No action was taken on these suggestions at this time.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned.
