

MINUTES OF THE 67th MEETING OF THE BOROUGH OF
 CHESTER HEIGHTS, PA. COUNCIL HELD IN THE BOROUGH
 SCHOOL BUILDING MONDAY AUGUST 6th 1951 at 8 P. M.

With a quorum present this meeting was called to order by
 President Willcox. Shortly thereafter all members were present

The Treasurers Report was approved as read.

Reply from Penna. Dept. of Highways concerning the intersection
 of Balto. Pike & Chester Heights Rd. read and turned over to
 Burgess Schrader for further follow-up.

Another communication from the Dept. of Highways in reference to
 the weight limit signs on the Railroad Bridge was read. Mr. Kinney,
 Dist. Engineer stated this was not under the jurisdiction of the
 Highway Dept. and suggested the Penna. R. R. be contacted. The
 Secretary was therefore authorized to write to the General Manager
 of the Penna. R. R. Co. on this subject.

Burgess Schrader suggested that the street light on Birney Hwy.
 opposite the Ross property be moved to the next pole alongside
 of the Fire House. It was moved and seconded and unaminously
 approved to have the Phila. Electric Co, make this change and
 install a larger lamp, and

the necessary funds be transferred from the Un-appropriated balance to take care of this additional charge.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned.
