

MINUTES OF THE 57th MONTHLY MEETING OF
THE BOROUGH OF CHESTER HEIGHTS PA. COUNCIL HELD
IN THE BOROUGH SCHOOL BUILDING
MONDAY NOVEMBER 5th 1951 at 8 P. M.

With a quorum present, this meeting was called to order by President Willcox. The absentee members were Councilmen, Wood, Kerns and Stromgren.

The minutes of the October meeting were approved as read.

At this time Mr. Dohan presented to Council a Petition, signed by more than fifty (50) per centum of the owners of the Zone A residential area of the Borough of Chester Heights, requesting an amendment to the Chester Heights Borough Zoning Ordinance of 1946 Section #912 to include in the list of prohibited uses in said section, the following;

Cement manufacturing
Gravel pits and stone-crushers
Kennels for dogs and cats
Public dump or rubbish disposal

Upon motion by Councilman Little, duly seconded, it was unanimously RESOLVED; that pursuant to Sections #800-801 of the Chester Heights Borough Zoning Ordinance of 1946, the Secretary of Council is hereby directed to cause notice of proposed amendments to the Ordinance to be given as required by Section #801, and that the time and place of the public hearing on the proposed amendments be 8.00 P. M. on Monday, December 3rd 1951, at the Chester Heights School, Chester Heights, Pennsylvania, respectively.
