

MINUTES OF THE 63rd MEETING OF THE BOROUGH  
OF CHESTER HEIGHTS PA. COUNCIL HELD IN THE BOROUGH SCHOOL  
BUILDING MONDAY MAY 5th 1952

The meeting was called to order by President Breneman, with all members present except Mr. Krebs, who is absent due to illness. The minutes of the April meeting were read and approved.

The following receipts were reported and handed to the Treas.,

The Burgess reported on his recent meeting with the Penna. Public Utility Commission at which time it was decided to order the Penna. Railroad Co. to place additional supports under their bridge within the Borough and to remove the weight limit signs.

Chief of Police John Voigt reported on Police activities during the month and stated that several additional "No Parking" signs would be installed in the vicinity of the School.

Mr. Voigt also read a letter which he desired to send to the District Engineer of the Highway Dept.
