

MINUTES OF THE 64th MEETING OF THE BOROUGH  
OF CHESTER HEIGHTS PA. COUNCIL HELD IN THE BOROUGH SCHOOL  
BUILDING MONDAY JUNE 2nd 1952 at 8.00 P. M.

This meeting was called to order by President Breneman with five members of Council present. The absentee members were Mr. Kerns and Mr. Little.

The minutes of the May meeting were approved.

The Treasurers Report was approved as read.

Under unfinished business the subject of the unauthorized building of the Logtown Fence Co. was brought under discussion. Upon motion, duly seconded it was unanimously Resolved that the Secretary be authorized to communicate with the Building Inspector regarding the violation of the Building Code at this location and request a report to Council at the July meeting. A copy of this letter to be sent to the Fire Marshall.

Under new business a letter from the Penna. Highway Dept. was read and a set of plans presented showing the proposed improvement of Route #1. A portion of this improvement is within the limits of the Borough of Chester Heights and involves the condemnation of a portion of the Grahme Wood property. Also submitted were the approving Resolutions for execution by Borough Council, which Resolutions if passed would automatically impose upon the Borough the responsibility for the assumption of property damages resulting from the condemnation of the required property.

Upon motion, duly seconded it was Resolved that the Secretary request the Borough Solicitor to furnish an opinion as to the Legal

liability and recommend the steps to be taken to meet the requirements of the Dept. of Highways.

It was also unanimously RESOLVED that a letter be written to the Dept. of Highways requesting a meeting of their representative with Mr. Irwin Little, Chairman of the Borough Highway Committee, Mr. Gus Houtman, the Borough Engineer and possibly Mr. Grahme Wood, to determine the value of the land, the costs involved in making the changes and what costs to be assumed by the Borough.

Director of Civil Defense Mr. John Voigt reported on the results of the recent Air raid Alert. Mr. Voigt explained that it would be necessary to equip 24 men to man the various posts in the Borough at a cost of approximately Ten Dollars per man. It was moved and seconded and unanimously approved that the Director of Civil Defense be authorized to purchase the necessary equipment required for 24 deputy wardens up to a total of \$250.00 and that an additional \$50.00 be transferred from the unappropriated balance to Civil Defense.

Mr. Wyeth Johnson and Mr. Samuel E. Jobson Jr. presented a report on the finances of the Chester Heights Fire Co. and the progress being made in completing the new Fire House.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
