The Treasurers report was approved.

Building Inspector, Mr. Jas. Townsend reported on the alledged violation of the Building Code on the property of the Logtown Fence Co. It was Mr. Townsends opinion that there is no actual violation but there is a definite fire hazard.

Mr. Kerns, the Borough Fire Marshall reported he had made an inspection of this property and had ordered the tenant to make the necessary changes to eliminate the fire hazard. Mr. Kerns stated he would make a further inspection and report accordingly. At this time Mr. John Kelly requested information on the building project in the camp grounda adjoining his property.

This matter was turned over to the Building Inspector for investigation.

A communication from Solicitor Hamilton stating his opinion as to the Borough's responsibility in assuming property damages due to the improvement of Baltimore Pike, was read.

It is Mr. Hamilton's opinion that it is not mandatory for the Borough to assume these damages and he suggested that the Highway Dept. be so notified.

Upon motion duly seconded, the Secretary was authorized to communicate with the Highway Dept. stating that the Budget of the Borough did not provide funds for property damages. The next order of business was the unanimous adoption of two Resolutions requesting the State Highway Dept. to erect "Stop" signs at the intersection of Bodley and Chester Heights Roads.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
