

MINUTES OF THE 66th MEETING OF THE BOROUGH OF

Treas Rep. (4 pp.)

Burgess Schrader presented a communication from the Penna. Public Utility Commission advising that the Penna. Railroad had completed all repairs necessary to make the bridge safe for legal loads and that the bridge restriction signs were removed. Mr. Schrader registered his objections to the manner in which the roadway of the bridge was repaired and stated he had received numerous complaints. It was Mr. Schraders understanding that the entire bridge roadway would be re-surfaced.

Upon motion, duly seconded, the Secretary was directed to reply to this letter stating the repairs to the roadway were unsatisfactory.

Building Inspector Mr. Jas. Townsend reported he had investigated the building project in the Camp on the Fritz property. Mr. Townsend stated he had ordered the work stopped and recommended the matter be referred to the Board of Adjustments. At this time Mr. Beam, of the Boy Scouts was presented to Council. Mr. Beam stated he had supervision of this camp and they were not erecting any additions or buildings, and that

the building project under discussion and investigation was only the screening of the dining hall.

Chief Voigt reported on police activities for the month..

The Zoning Committee reported progress.
