

MINUTES OF THE 73rd MEETING OF THE BOROUGH OF CHESTER
HEIGHTS COUNCIL HELD IN THE BOROUGH SCHOOL BUILDING
MONDAY MARCH 2nd 1953 AT 8.00 P. M.

With a quorum present this meeting was called to order by
President Breneman. The absentee members being, Mr. Kerns,
Mr. Townsend and Mr. Wood.

The minutes of the February meeting were approved as read.

The following receipts were reported and handed to the Treas;

The Treasurers Report was approved as presented and correspondence
handled.

Burgess Schrader advised Council on the unsafe conditions
existing on the property of the abandoned quarry in the Borough
and suggested a letter to the property owner or a personal call
by himself in order to have this hazard corrected.

Mr. Little, Chairman of the Highway Committee, in reporting on
the condition of the Borough Highways recommended that the rate
for labor on the highways be increased from the present rate of
One Dollar per hour and that the Street Supervisor be compensated
for the use of his truck when engaged on highway work. Mr. Little
requested that this increase be retroactive to Feb. 1st 1953.

Upon motion, duly seconded, it was approved that the rate of
One Dollar and thirty-two cents (\$1.32) per hour be paid for labor
on the highways within the Borough and that the Street Supervisor
be compensated at the rate of Forty-five cents per hour for the
use of his truck when engaged on highway work and that this
increased rate is effective as of February 1st 1953.

Mr. Geo. Wilson and Mr. Wyeth Johnson presented the Financial and Fire Reports of the Chester Heights Volunteer Fire Co. for the past year. Mr. Wilson stated these reports would be presented yearly.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
