The Treasurers Report was approved as presented.

Burgess Schrader reported on a recent accident on Rt 261 and traffic conditions in general. Supplementing the Burgess' report, Mr. Breneman stated he had made a personal check on traffic violations along Rt 261 and observed that the drivers would obey traffic regulations only when they realized they were being checked. Mr. Breneman requested the Committee on Public Safety consider part time Police Protection on the highways of the Borough.

Chairman Little of the Highway Committee presented two bids on the re-surfacing of Mattson Road, but no action was taken at this time.

A communication from Vincent P. Desmond, Atty., for John J. Kelly, addressed to the Zoning Board of Adjustments, regarding the Camp on the Fritz property, was read. Mr. Desmond requested that he be furnished certain information by the Building Inspector as to the cubical contents of the buildings of the camp. Mr. Jos. Townsend assured Council that this would be turned over to the Building Inspector for handling.
