

MINUTES OF THE 78th MEETING OF THE BOROUGH OF CHESTER HEIGHTS COUNCIL HELD IN THE BOROUGH SCHOOL BUILDING MONDAY AUGUST 3rd 1953 AT 8.00 P. M.

The Treasurers Report was approved and correspondence read. Chairman Little of the Highway Comm. presented two additional estimates for re-surfacing Matson Road. As these bids were in excess of Four Hundred Dollars, motion was made and seconded to have the Boro. Engineer survey the section of Matson Rd. within the Boro, limits to determine the extent of repairs necessary and prepare specifications. These specifications to be used in advertising for bids.

At this time Mr. Brown, representing the Bell Telephone Co. of Penna., requested Borough Council to adopt an Ordinance granting the Bell Telephone Company a franchise to operate within the Borough of Chester Heights. Mr. Brown proceeded to read and explain the proposed ordinance to Council.
