

MINUTES OF THE 83rd MEETING OF THE BOROUGH OF CHESTER HEIGHTS
COUNCIL HELD IN THE BOROUGH SCHOOL BUILDING JANUARY 4th 1954 at 8.00 PM

The meeting was called to order by President Breneman, with all members present.

The minutes of the December meeting were approved as read.

The Treasurers report was approved as presented.

Mr. Theo. Buckley administered the Oath of Office to the following elected officers; Burgess Mr. Irwin K. Little, Councilmen, Mr. Edwin B. Hobaugh, Mr. Arthur E. Stromgren, Mr. Jos. Townsend and Mr. Grahame Wood, Jr.

As this is the re-organization meeting for the ensuing term of two years, the election of officers was next in order.

Mr. H. Herbert ^{Breneman} was nominated for President and Mr. Grahame Wood, Jr was nominated for Vice-President. Upon motion, duly seconded, nominations were declared closed and Mr. Breneman was unanimously elected President and Mr. Grahame Wood was unanimously elected Vice-President.

Nominations for Secretary and Treasurer were next in order, with the result Hilton E. Jones was unanimously elected Secretary and Miss Anna D. Dickson unanimously elected Treasurer.

Nominations were declared open for Solicitor.

The name of Mr. John F. Cramp was placed in nomination. Mr. Wood stated that Mr. Cramp would serve as Solicitor for the Borough for a retainer fee of One hundred and fifty (\$150.00) per year

with additional compensation for attending Council meetings. Upon motion, duly seconded, nominations were declared closed and Mr. Cramp was unanimously appointed Solicitor.

Nominations for Building Inspector were next in order, with the result Mr. James Townsend was unanimously appointed.

Upon motion, which was seconded, it was unanimously approved that the compensation for the Burgess and the Secretary remain as hereto fore, namely, Burgess \$25.00 per year and Secretary \$25.00 per month.

It was moved, seconded and unanimously RESOLVED that the bonds for the Treasurer, Secretary and Solicitor be renewed in their present amounts.

Upon motion which was seconded, it was unanimously RESOLVED that the First National Bank of Delaware County, Media, Pa., be continued as the depository of all Borough Funds.
