

MINUTES OF THE 84th MEETING OF THE BOROUGH OF CHESTER HEIGHTS  
COUNCIL HELD IN THE BOROUGH SCHOOL BUILDING MONDAY FEB. 1st 1954 8.00PM

The next order of business was the adoption of the proposed Budget for the Year 1954. The Secretary read the Budget as prepared by the Finance Committee, listing estimated expenditures of \$2450.15 and estimated receipts of \$2599.20. After a short discussion on the unappropriated balance, a motion was made and seconded and unanimously Resolved that the Budget for the Year 1954 be adopted as presented.

The next order of business was the fixing of the Tax Rate for the year 1954. Upon motion, duly seconded, it was unanimously Resolved;

TAX ORDINANCE #25

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF CHESTER HEIGHTS, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, fixing the tax rate for the fiscal year 1954.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Council of the Borough of Chester Heights,

Commonwealth of Pennsylvania,

Section 1. That a tax be and the same is hereby levied on all property within the said Borough subject to taxation for Borough purposes for the fiscal year 1954 as follows;

Tax rate for general Borough purposes, the sum of Four (4) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation.

Section 2. That any ordinance, or part of ordinance, conflicting with this ordinance be and the same is hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this ordinance.
