

MINUTES OF THE 86th MEETING OF THE BOROUGH OF CHESTER HEIGHTS COUNCIL HELD IN THE BOROUGH SCHOOL BUILDING MONDAY APRIL 5th 1954 8 PM

The meeting was called to order by President Breneman with all members present excepting Mr. Krebs.

The minutes of the February meeting were approved after correction noted, whereas Mr. Tucker was advised to cease operations in violation to the Zoning Ordinance.

The Treasurers report was approved as presented.

Burgess Report; Mr. Little reported that upon investigation of trash dumped on the Krebs property evidence had<sup>been</sup> found identifying the guilty party and the necessary action would be taked.

Mr. Little reported he had called on Mr. Small, who was issued a permit on Aug. 23rd 1952 for the erection of a dwelling.

Mr. Little stated a garage had been erected and was being used as a dwelling and that very little progress has been made to erect the house. This was referred to the Build Inspector for further investigation.

Highway Committee reported progress.

Mr. Hobough requested that his property be re-classified from B to A residential. This was referred to the Zoning Committee for further study.

Mr, Hobough stated that a report on the Financial requirements of the School Board would be rendered at a later date.

A motion, duly seconded was unanimously approved to pay the sum of Three Hundered Dollars (\$300.00) to the School Board of Chester

Heights for light, heat and power for the year 1954, and the sum of Four Hundred Dollars (\$400.00) to the Chester Heights Volunteer Fire Company as a contribution for the year 1954. Mr. John Voigt, road Supervisor reported that the correct location of the boundary between Concord Township and Chester Heights Borough on Mattson Road has been established and the Chester Heights sign erected at that spot.

The Highway Committee was directed to obtain an up-to date survey and map of the Borough showing the Borough limits and streets in order that the proper signs could be erected. There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
