

MINUTES OF THE 87th MEETING OF THE BOROUGH OF CHESTER HEIGHTS
COUNCIL HELD IN THE BOROUGH SCHOOL BUILDING MONDAY MAY 3rd 1954 8 PM

The meeting was called to order by President Breneman. The absentee members were Mr. Kerns & Mr. Townsend.

The minutes of the April meeting were approved after correction noted, whereas the request of Mr. Hobough for a change of Zoning classification referred to the area of Rt. 261 & Rt. 1.

The following receipts were reported and handed to the Treas.;

The Treas. Report was approved as presented.

Burgess Little stated he had not as yet received a report from the Building Inspector regarding the Small property.

Mr. Stromgren, reporting for the Highway Committee, presented a list of names, selected by his committee after a survey of the Borough, for the various Borough roads or streets. The only exception noted was the naming of Wawa or Church Road. Mr. Stromgren stated that another poll of the residents of this road would be taken and the results reported at the next meeting.

A motion was made, seconded and unanimously RESOLVED, that the Highway Committee is hereby authorized to proceed with the preparation of an Ordinance naming the streets and roads of the Borough of Chester Heights.

Mr. Stromgren also presented a display of various metal signs for street markers and recommended that twenty-four signs be

purchased.

Upon motion, duly seconded, it was unanimously agreed that upon approval of the Ordinance naming the Borough roads, the Highway Committee is authorized to purchase 24 cast aluminum street markers.

Motion was made, seconded, and unanimously approved, that the bid of the Valley Brook Construction Co. of \$744.00, for the resurfacing of Mattson Road be accepted.

Mr. Samuel Jobson reported delinquent taxes for the year 1953 returned to the County Treasurer in the amount of \$111.00.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
