

MINUTES OF THE 92nd MEETING OF THE BOROUGH OF CHESTER HEIGHTS
COUNCIL HELD IN THE BOROUGH SCHOOL BUILDING MONDAY AUGUST 9th 1954

With a quorum present the meeting was called to order by Vice-President Wood. The absentee members were Mr. Breneman and Mr. Stromgren.

The minutes of the July 6th regular meeting and the special meeting held on July 26th were approved.

The minutes of the public hearing which was held on July 26th, were also read and approved.

In the absence of Miss Dickson, the treasurers report was presented by the Secretary and correspondance read.

Burgess Little reported that the War Memorial was in bad condition. This would be referred to Mr. Jas. Townsend for the necessary repairs. The Highway Committee report presented by Mr. Hobough advised that the re-paving of Matson Road had been completed.

Mr. Jos. Townsend presented the ammendments to the Chester Heights Borough Zoning Ordinance for adoption.

Upon motion, which was seconded, it was unanimously RESOLVED, that the ammendments to the Chester Heights Borough Zoning Ordinance of 1946, which were approved by Borough Council on July 26th 1954 are hereby adopted.

Motion was made and seconded and unanimously approved that the Dela. County Planning Comm. be requested to proceed with the

project for future planning of the Borough, as outlined in the communication present ed by Mr. Townsend, at a cost to the Borough of two hundred to ^{250 - FIFTY} three hundred dollars. (250)

The next order of business was the appointment of a Councilman to fill the unexpired term of Mr. Krebs, deceased.

Mr. Wood appointed a committee composed of Mr. Kerns and Mr. Hobough to select and recommend at the Sept. meeting of Council an appointee to fill this vacancy.

It was moved, seconded and unanimously approved that Project Agreement, Form #972, under the provisions of Act #340, and Application Form #998 for improvement of Matson Road be executed and forwarded to the Penna. Dept. of Highways.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
