

MINUTES OF THE 96th MEETING OF THE BOROUGH OF CHESTER HEIGHTS COUNCIL  
HELD IN THE BOROUGH SCHOOL BUILDING MONDAY DECEMBER 6th 1954 8 P. M.

This meeting was called to order by President Breneman with all members present excepting Mr. Hobough and Mr. Townsend.

Mr. Theo. Buckley administered the Oath of Office to Mr. Arthur Brant as a member of Borough Council to serve the unexpired term of Mr. Krebs.

The Minutes of the meeting of Nov. 18th were approved as read.

The Treasurers Report was approved as presented and correspondance read.

Mr. Breneman requested further action by Council in an effort to have the dangerous traffic condition on Rt. #1 in the vicinity of Darlington Road eliminated. Since there has been one fatal accident and several others of lesser degree on this section of the highway it was Moved and seconded and unanimously RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Committee on Public Safety again communicate with the Penna. Dept. of Highways on behalf of Borough Council requesting that this dangerous condition be corrected.

The next order of business was the adoption of Ordinance #27.

This Ordinance, changing and re-designating the names of certain public roads and confirming the names of the remaining public roads

within the Borough, according to the Borough Map, was read by the Secretary.

It was then moved, seconded, and unanimously approved and hereby adopted.

The new highway signs, which will be delivered in a few weeks, were placed on display by a representative of the Keystone Hi-Way Traffic Equipment Co.

Upon Motion, which was seconded, it was unanimously approved that the Highway Committee be authorized to purchase the necessary 2" pipe and other materials, not to exceed One hundred and twenty-five Dollars, for the erection of these signs.

President Breneman appointed Mr. Arthur Brant to fill the vacancy on the Financial Committee, this committee to meet and prepare the Budget for 1955.

Mr. Theo. Buckley informed Council that the Penna. Highway Dept. have removed the Rt#261 signs from the highway in Bethel Twsp. and Chester Heights Boro. Although no official notification has been received from the Penna. Highway Dept., it is assumed that this section of highway may ~~be~~ eventually be turned back to the Borough. Upon motion, which was seconded, it was unanimously RESOLVED, that Mr. Buckley is authorized, on behalf of Borough Council, to attend a meeting called by the Commissioners of Bethel Township for the purpose of requesting the Penna. Highway Dept. to re-instate Rt. #261 in this area.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
