

MINUTES OF THE 99th MEETING OF THE BOROUGH OF CHESTER HEIGHTS COUNCIL
HELD IN THE BOROUGH SCHOOL BUILDING MONDAY MARCH 7th 1955 at 8 P. M.

The meeting was called to order by President Breneman with all members present excepting Mr. Brant and Mr Hobaugh.

Burgess Little reported further on the complaint of Miss Souder and since another letter from Miss Souder had been received it was suggested that this matter be referred to the Solicitor for a ruling.

Mr. Little also reported the dumping of rubbish on Darlington Rd.

This was referred to the Highway Committee.

The Highway Committee reported that the new street signs have been erected.

Mr. Buckley advised that the Highway Dept. had replaced the Rt. 261 signs within the Borough and Bethel Twsp.

Acting on the verbal complaint registered by Mrs. Rinehart regarding the manner in which the stone trucks are operated through the Borough, it was moved, seconded and unanimously approved that the Secretary address a letter to the Officer in charge of the State Police Headquarters at Media on the traffic conditions within the Borough.

Due to the removal of Mr. Willcox from the Borough, a vacancy was declared in the office of Borough Auditor.

President Breneman called for nominations and the name of Mrs. Herbert Brenaman was presented. Nominations were then declared closed and the Secretary was directed to cast the ballot appointing Mrs. Breneman as Borough Auditor to serve the unexpired term of Mr. Mark Willcox, which term expires on the first Monday of January 1956.
