Burgess Report; Mr. Little reported that the white center line on Valley Brook Rd. which was recently repainted by the Hwy. Dept. did not extend to the intersection of Rt. #1. It was Mr. Little's opinion that if this line were to be continued it may help to eliminate some of the existing confusion at this busy intersection. This was referred to the Highway Committee with instructions to communicate with the Penna. Dept. of Highways.

No further committee reports were presented.

At this time President Breneman called for nominations for the office of Assist. Building Inspector. The name of Mr. Newton Townsend was proposed and nominations were declared closed. The Secretary was then directed to cast the ballot for Mr. Townsend.
