

MINUTES OF THE SEVENTH MONTHLY MEETING OF  
THE BOROUGH OF CHESTER HEIGHTS, PA.  
HELD IN THE VOIGT BLDG. MONDAY  
JULY 1st. 1946 at 8 P.M.

With all Councilmen present the President called this seventh monthly meeting to order.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read by the Secretary and unanimously adopted.

The Secretary next read several communications received from various sources during the preceeding month, one of which was a letter from Chairman C.L. Conner of the Delaware County Commissioners, enclosing a new map of Delaware County and offering to supply copies to Councilman upon request. The Secretary was directed to write Mr. Conner requesting about 24 copies of this excellent map.

The subject of the Board of Health came up for discussion and it was suggested by Council the Board designate a "Health Inspector" for the purpose of posting quarantine signs when necessary and doing other routine work.

Highway Commissioner Irwin K. Little reported upon the findings of his committee regarding speed signs for the Borough with the result the report was approved and it was unanimously

67 RESOLVED, that 35 M.P.H. speed signs be posted on all Borough Roads after first submitting the program to the Penna. Dep't. of Highways for approval.

Mr. Keller reported on the Zoning Committee work and said they have devided the Borough into 3 Zones classified as A.B. and C. and believe after his committee has one more meeting their proposed ordinances will be ready for the action of Council.

Mr. Keller requested Council authorize him to purchase typed copies of the proposed ordinances.

Council therefor

68 RESOLVED, the Budget be revised, establishing a "General Fund" into which all miscellaneous revenue be placed and allot from this fund \$25.00 for use of the Zoning Committee to defray expenses of typing copies of the proposed ordinance.

The sum of \$75.00 in fines was turned into Council by J of P Buckley representing penalties collected for violations of the Motor Vehicle Code during the month of June.

The subject of a meeting place for Council was discussed and Mr. Townsend, Pres. of the School Board invited the Borough Council to make use of the School Building for that purpose. It was therefor

69 RESOLVED, unanimously that Council accept this kind invitation and hold their first meeting in the School Bldg. Monday Aug.5th at 8 P.M.

There being no further business, a motion was made and seconded and unanimously carried to adjourn this meeting.
