

MINUTES OF NINETH MONTHLY MEETING OF
THE BOROUGH OF CHESTER HEIGHTS, PA.
HELD IN THE BOROUGH SCHOOL BLDG. MONDAY
SEPTEMBER 9th. 1946 at 8 P.M.

This meeting got under way with all members of Council present except Councilman Kerns and Breneman. Mr. Breneman arrived before the close of the meeting.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read by the Secretary and unanimously approved by Council.

A bill for \$4.00 labor on the road from Street Commissioner John Voigt was presented to council and unanimously approved for payment.

The Treasurer, Mrs. Josephine Breneman read her report which was likewise unanimously approved.

81 A motion was made; seconded and unanimously carried to Amend the resolution adopted Aug. 5, 1946 to pay 3% of the Tax Duplicate; to read 3% of taxes collected.

Following the above resolution an other motion was made and carried unanimously to pay Tax Collector, Samuel Jobson 3% of Taxes collected and turned into the Borough Secretary. The first amount collected and turned in at the Aug. 5th. 1946 meeting was \$589.57 and the second amount collected and turned in at this the Sep't. 9th. 1946 meeting was \$2,139.59. The total collected to and including this date is \$2,729.16 - 3% of which amounts to \$81.87.

82 A motion was made and seconded and it was RESOLVED unanimously, that \$300.00 be transferred out of the Budget item "Materials and Supplies" - Hgy. Dep't. to the Budget item of "Legal Expenses".

Council directed that the Secretary get 50 copies of all future ordinances published in Newspapers.

A motion was made; seconded and it was unanimously RESOLVED,

the Borough Police be authorized to see property owners regarding the removal of obstructions to vision at the junction of highways as a measure to reduce the possibility of traffic accidents upon the Boroughs Highways.

There being no further business to come before Council a motion to adjourn was made; seconded and unanimously carried and the meeting adjourned.
