

MINUTES OF THE TENTH MONTHLY MEETING OF
THE BOROUGH OF CHESTER HEIGHTS, PA.
HELD IN THE BOROUGH SCHOOL BLDG. MONDAY
OCTOBER 7th. 1946 at 8 P.M.

All members of Council, except Mr. Strongren, were present when J. Taney Willcox, Pres. of Council called this meeting to order promptly at 8 o'clock.

The Secretary read the minutes of the September meeting which were unanimously approved.

Police Reports from Constable George Wilson and John S. Voigt were read and the Secretary directed to place these reports in the proper file.

At the request of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Department of Highways the following resolution was passed unanimously by Council.

83 RESOLVED, whereas the Borough Council desires to limit the speed on State Highway 23026 in the Borough of Chester Heights in the County of Delaware between Station 0 + 00, Int. with L.R. 23026 and Station 50 + 45, Int. with L.R. 131 and

Whereas, Signs will be required in accordance with the provisions of the Vehicle Code and the Manual of Regulations for Official Traffic Signs and Signals.

Now, Therefore, Be it Resolved, that the speed on State Highway 23016 from Station 0 + 00 to Station 50 + 45 shall be and is hereby limited to 35 miles per hour, and

Be it Further Resolved, That the Borough of Chester Heights does hereby request the Department of Highways to authorize the erection of sign on said State Highway Route in accordance with The Vehicle Code, and the Manual of Regulations, and

Be it Further Resolved, that speed on said State Highway shall not be restricted unless or until the Secretary of High-

ways approves this resolution and authorizes the erection of the necessary signs as above.

85 RESOLVED, that regular monthly reports in person or in writing be made by all responsible department heads and Committee Chairman and that a notice of each monthly meeting be sent to them.

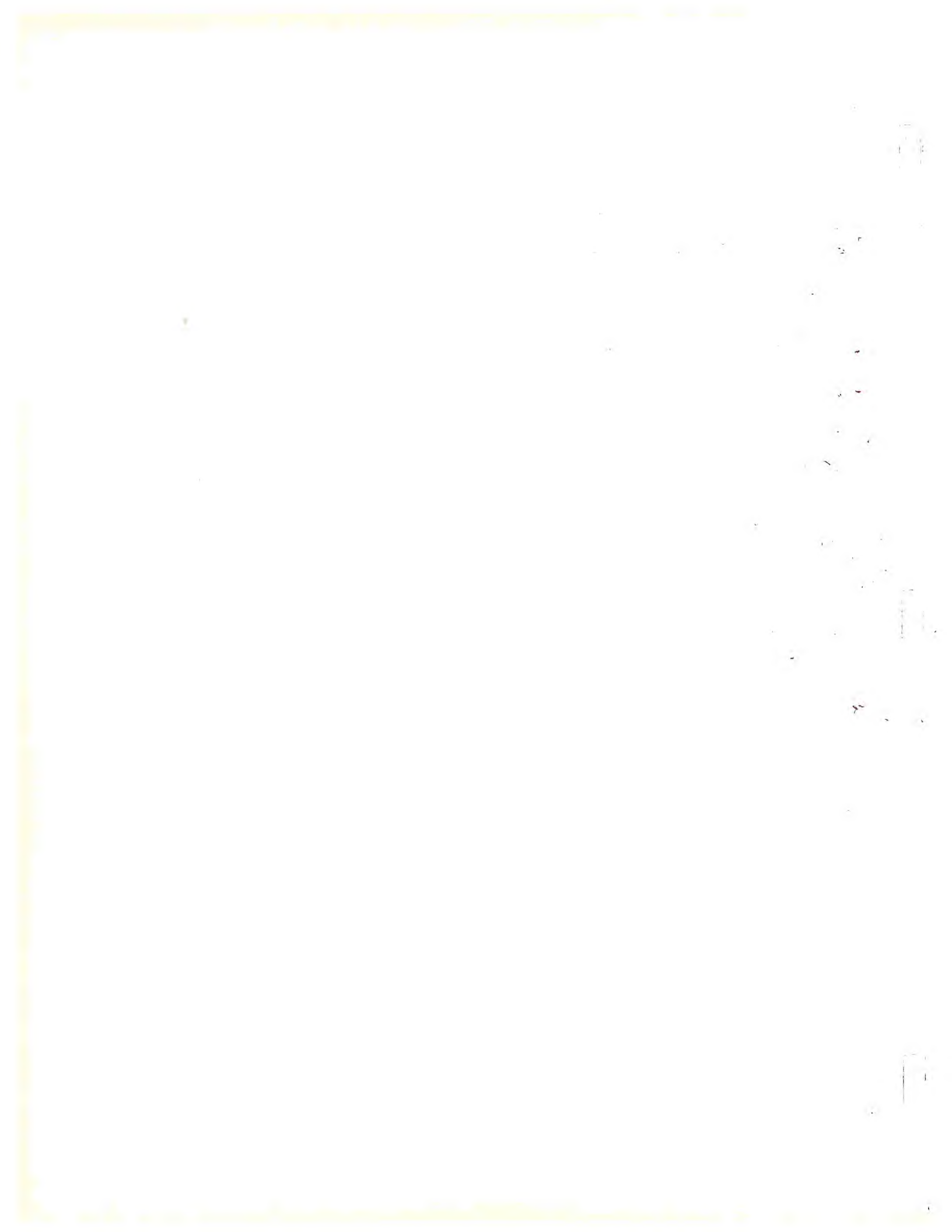
Mr. Claude A. Tucker inquired of Council what, if anything, was being done regarding the R.R. service thru Chester Heights and made particular reference to the withdrawal of the 11 A.M. train to Phila. Discussion resulted and Mr. Tucker consequently advised this subject had been taken up by Council several months ago at which time they held this matter was not a proper one for Council to act upon but rather for the consolidated effort of all the users of Railroad from Oxford to Wawa. The President Mr. Willcox, however, again inquired if any member of Council cared to make a motion on this subject. ~~There being no motion or further discussion the subject was dropped.~~

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Borough of Chester Heights does hereby request the Department of Highways to authorize the erection of signs on said State Highway Route in accordance with The Vehicle Code, and the Manual of regulations, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That speed on said State Highway shall not be restricted unless or until the Secretary of Highways approves this resolution and authorizes the erection of the necessary signs as above.
