

FREE Meals for Garnet Valley Community Children 18 and Under



Dear School Community,

As the COVID-19 pandemic continues to impact our daily lives, Garnet Valley School District, through waivers granted by the U.S. Department of Agriculture, will begin offering FREE meals to children in the community who are 18 years or younger, beginning Monday, November 30, 2020.

Free meals will be available to all children 18 and under residing in our Garnet Valley community – Distribution of these meals will follow the methods below:

- **Hybrid Students –** When students are in school, meals will be provided following normal lunch procedures. For virtual days, meals will be available for pick up once a week.
 - **Example:** If a student is in school Monday and Wednesday – a meal pick up will be available containing meals for Tuesday, Thursday and Friday. Meal reservation forms and schedule of pick up dates and locations will be provided.
- **100% Virtual Students & Community children –** Once a week meal pick up will be available, this will provide a package of meals for Monday through Friday. Meal reservation forms and schedule of pick up dates and locations are provided on our [Garnet Valley Food Service website](#).

The District remains committed to providing nutritious meals to students; all students are strongly encouraged to take advantage of the free meals the District can now offer.
