

MINUTES OF THE 113th MEETING OF THE BORO. OF CHESTER HEIGHTS COUNCIL
HELD IN THE BORO. SCHOOL BUILDING MONDAY MAY 7th 1956 at 8 P. M.

The meeting was called to order by President Wood, with all members present excepting Mr. Stromgren and Mr. Townsend.

The minutes of the April meeting were read and unanimously approved.

The Treasurers Report was approved as presented by Miss Dickson.

Building Inspector Mr. Urban reported he had inspected the property at Wawa Station and had offered several suggestions to the present occupant that would give this property a better appearance.

Mr. Arthur Brandt, reporting for the Committee on Public Safety, stated he had made an inspection of the dump at Lenni, which is used for the dumping and burning of trash by the Aldon Rug Mills and which constitutes a violation of the Borough Ordinance #6.

It was then moved and seconded, and unanimously approved, that the Secretary notify the Aldon Rug Mills to refrain from further dumping and burning of trash within sixty (60) days, with the alternative of appearing before Borough Council.

It was agreed by the members present that a check to the Fire Company in the amount of \$500.00 Dollars, which represents one-third of the annual appropriation, and a check in the amount of \$300.00 to the School Board, be drawn at this time.

Mr. Wood stated he had not as yet prepared a study on the Borough Assessments but expected to do so in the near future.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
