

MINUTES OF THE 115th MEETING OF THE BORO. OF CHESTER HEIGHTS COUNCIL
HELD IN THE BORO. SCHOOL BUILDING MONDAY JULY 2nd 1956 at 8.00 P. M.

The meeting was called to order by President Wood, with all members present excepting Mr. Brandt and Mr. Stromgren.

Mr. John Cramp, Boro. Solicitor was also present.

The minutes of the June meeting were read and approved.

The Treasurer's Report was approved as presented by Miss. Dickson.

Mr. John Voigt, reporting for the Public Safety Committee, advised that he had inspected several open and uncovered excavations on the property of Mr. John McManus, that he had placed a temporary cover over the most dangerous hole and he had also phoned Mr. McManus' office, requesting that these holes be filled in or properly enclosed.

Upon motion, which was seconded, it was unanimously approved that the Secretary write a letter to Mr. McManus requesting that these holes be filled in or covered over with heavy planks in such a manner that the possibility of an accident will be eliminated.

It was then moved, seconded and unanimously approved that the Boro. Solicitor is authorized to draft an Ordinance regulating all excavations within the Borough.

Unfinished business; Of the three bids sent out on the printing of the Zoning Ordinance, the only reply was from the Media Press with a bid of \$160.00 for 500 copies. It was moved and seconded,

and unanimously approved that this printing job be awarded to the Media Press.

Mr. Wood reported that a meeting was held with the Boro. Tax Assessor, Mr. Fred Favinger, on the subject of Borough Assessments and the furnishing to the Assessor, a copy of all Building Permits and Certificates of Occupancy. Adjustments to the Assessment list will be discussed at a future meeting.

The next order of Business was a discussion on the dump at the Aldon Rug Mill. Mr. Louis Essaf, Plant Manager of this organization, who was present at the invitation on Council, declared his intentions to conform to the provisions of Ord. #6 and to fully co-operate in every way possible. His request for permission to continue the burning of trash on this property was tabled until the August meeting, at which time Mr. Essaf will present a written statement listing the improvements he will establish to eliminate this unsightly condition and the precautions to be taken in order to control the burning of trash.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
