

MINUTES OF THE 116th. MEETING OF THE BORO. OF CHESTER HEIGHTS COUNCIL
HELD IN THE BORO. SCHOOL BUILDING MONDAY AUGUST 6th 1956 AT 8.00 P. M.

The meeting was called to order by President Wood, with all members present excepting Mr. Brandt.

The minutes of the July meeting were read and approved.

The Treasurers Report as presented by Miss Dickson was approved.

Burgess Little reported a serious auto accident had occurred on the lower end of Lenni Road at the boundary of Aston Twsp. As this has always been a dangerous intersection, it was suggested that most of the danger could be eliminated by widening the roadway at this point. As this is a State Highway and within the limits of Aston Township therefore it was moved and seconded, and unanimously approved that the Secretary should request the co-operation of the Aston Township Commissioners on this matter. Mr. John Voigt, reporting for the Public Safety Committee, recommended that the wattage of three street lights be increased from the present 1000 lumen to 2500 lumen. These lights are located as follows; Pole #89 at the P.R.R. bridge, Pole #107 at Smith Bridge Road and Pole #110 at Llewelyn Road.

Upon motion, which was seconded, it was unanimously approved that the Secretary request the Phila. Electric Co. to make this change.

Unfinished business; Mr. Edgar Urban presented a sample copy of a Certificate of Occupancy with the request that he be furnished with a supply of this form. It was then moved and seconded and unanimously approved that the Secretary should have 500 of these forms printed.

Having received no reply to the letter which was sent to Mr. John McManus regarding the unguarded excavation on his property, the Secretary was directed to send a second letter to Mr. McManus requesting a reply.

The Secretary presented a letter received from the Aldon Rug Mills in which Mr. Louis Essaf stated the action he has undertaken to clean up the dumping area and listing the program he has installed in order to control this situation in the future. It was moved and seconded that the Secretary should reply with a letter of thanks to Mr. Essaf for his co-operation on this matter.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
