

MINUTES OF THE 121st MEETING OF THE BORO. OF CHESTER HEIGHTS COUNCIL  
HELD IN THE BORO. SCHOOL BUILDING MONDAY JANUARY 7th at 8.00 P. M.

The meeting was called to order by President Wood, with all members present.

The Minutes of the December meeting were approved.

The report of the Treasurer was unanimously approved.

Report of Highway Comm. Mr Hobough reported on the placing of signs and Highway markings at all School crossings, and that the removal of rubbish from the Highways would be handled by Mr. Voigt.

Unfinished business; In accordance with the recommendations and plan of the Phila. Electric Company for three additional street lights on Llewelyn Road it was moved and seconded and unanimously approved that the Phila. Electric Company be authorized to proceed with the installation as proposed.

In reply to a second request for the appointment of a Civil Defense Director for the Borough, the Secretary was directed to inform the Dela. County Office of Civil Defense that this matter is under consideration by the Borough Officials.

New Business; At this time Mr. Wood called for nominations to fill the vacancy on Borough Council. Mr. Chester Anderson and Mr. Robert Sparkman were nominated. Ballots were cast by the members present and Mr. Anderson received the majority vote. It was then moved and seconded and unanimously Resolved that Mr. Anderson is hereby appointed to fill the unexpired term of Mr. Arthur Stromgren as Councilman. This term to expire on the first Monday of January 1958.
