"RESOLVED, by the Council of the Borough of Chester Heights, that the following corrections be made to the Chester Heights Borough Zoning Ordinance of 1946, effective as of April 2nd 1957. The corrections are necessitated due to errors in the printing and editing and in no way alter the intent of the Ordinance.

1. Section 103.4 last line to read "with sections #501 to #504 of this Ordinance.
2. Section 200.8 line #4 to read "Camps and camp ground of a temporary duration subject to Sec. #401.

- 3. Section 230.4 to read "Any retail business or service, provided the same does not violate the provisions of Section #416 and #417.
- 4. Section 408.5 first line to read "In addition to the other requirements of this Section #408.
