Zoning; At this time the Secretary read a letter of Aug. 7th from the Zoning Board of Adjustment and addressed to Mr. Benj. Levin outlining the terms of the special exception granted for the use of a portion of the former Walnut Hills property as a riding stable. Following a discussion as to the status of the Produce stand which is operating on this property President Wood appointed Mr. Breneman as a committee of one to co-operate with Mr. Theo. Buckley to investigate the facts with the Boro. Solicitor and to proceed with any action which may be necessary to force the operators of this stand to comply to the terms of the Borough Zoning Ordinance.

Public Safety; The problem of speeding trucks was again discussed at considerable length following several complaints registered by residents of Valleybrook Road. President Wood

appointed the following committee to write to and call upon the commanding officer of the State Police at the Media Barracks to discuss and endeavor to correct this dangerous condition, Mr. Breneman, Mr. Hobough, Mr. Voigt and Mr. Theo. Buckley.

New Business; Mrs. Harding and Mrs. Reinhart, of Valleybrook Road requested the installation of two street lights on the lower end of Valleybrook Rd. This was referred to the Highway committee to determine which poles these lights should be installed upon.

Mr. John McManus presented and explained plans for the development of his property at Wawa & Valleybrook Rds.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
