

MINUTES OF THE 132nd MEETING OF THE BORO. OF CHESTER HEIGHTS COUNCIL HELD  
IN THE BORO. SCHOOL BUILDING MONDAY DECEMBER 2nd. 1957 at 8.00 P. M.

The meeting was called to order by President Wood, with all members present excepting Mr. Hobaugh and Mr. Jobson.

The Treas. report was approved as presented by Miss Dickson. Burgess report; Mr. Little reported that the Riding Academy had vacated the former Walnut Hills property as of Nov. 20th. Building Inspector report; Mr. Voigt reported on the building activities and inspections during the past month.

Unfinished Business

As a result of a canvas conducted by the Highway Comm. it has been decided not to accept the proposal of Aston Twsp. to share the expense of additional street lighting on Lenni Road at this time.

A discussion was held on the enforcement of the Building and plumbing regulations.

Upon motion, which was seconded and unanimously approved, the Secretary was directed to request the Borough Solicitor to render an opinion on the legal requirements and procedures necessary for the proper enforcement of Borough Ordinances.

New Business

Communication from Mrs. Elsie West, Ticket Agent and Postmistress at Wawa, advising on the proposed closing of all Ticket Offices between Media and West Chester, was read.

The Secretary was directed to register a protest with the Public Utility Commission on the closing of these Stations.

Mr. Schroeder reported considerable trash had been thrown on his property on Wawa Road and upon examination evidence that the trash came from a resident of the Borough was found. Mr. Schroeder was advised to file a complaint with the Justice of Peace for the prosecution of the guilty party.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
