

MINUTES OF THE 133rd MEETING OF THE COUNCIL OF THE BORO. OF CHESTER HEIGHTS, HELD IN THE BORO. SCHOOL BUILDING MONDAY JANUARY 6th 1958 at 8.00 PM

Due to the absence of the Burgess, Mr. Grahame Wood was elected to preside over the organization meeting. Justice of Peace Theo. Buckley administered the Oath of Office to the following newly elected Councilmen for the term of four years, Mr. Chester Anderson, Mr. Edwin B. Hobaugh, Mr. Samuel Jobson and Mr. Joseph B. Townsend. The other members present were Mr. Breneman and Mr. Ward. The next order of business was the election of officers for the term of two years.

Nominations for the office of President were declared open. Mr. Wood, Mr. Breneman, Mr. Hobaugh and Mr. Townsend were duly nominated for this office and nominations declared closed.

Ballots were cast with the result that Mr. Jos. Townsend was elected President of Council by majority vote.

Mr. H. Herbert ^{Breneman} was unanimously elected Vice-President.

Hilton E. Jones was unanimously elected Secretary with Mrs. Kerns Ass't. Secretary. Miss Anna Dickson was unanimously elected Treasurer with Mrs. Herbert Breneman as Ass't. Treasurer.

The organization of Council has now been completed and all of the newly elected officers installed.

President Townsend called for the reading of the Minutes of the December meeting which were presented by the Secretary and unanimously approved.

It was unanimously Resolved that the Provident Trust Co. be continued as the depository for all Borough Funds.

There were no reports presented by the various committees. The Budget Committee composed of Mr. Breneman, Mr. Hobaugh and Mr. Ward advised the 1958 Budget would be prepared for presentation at the February meeting.

New Business; Request of Mr. John S. McManus, enclosing plans and specifications, that the Borough assume maintenance of the roadway that is currently being installed on his property at Valleybrook and Wawa Roads, was presented to Council.

Mr. McManus proposes to erect five homes and have this property completely developed during 1958. The roadway is expected to be installed by April 15th. and will be conveyed to the Borough within one year of its completion.

Upon motion, which was seconded and unanimously approved, the Secretary was directed to inform Mr. McManus that the Borough of Chester Heights would accept maintenance of this roadway after certificates of occupancy have been issued for at least three new homes and the roadway dedicated to the Borough, with all costs of conveyance to be borne by Mr. McManus.

Upon motion by Mr. Wood, which was seconded and unanimously approved, the Secretary was directed to register a protest with the Penna. Public Utility Commission against the proposed closing of Wawa Ticket Office with a copy of the letter to the Penna. Railroad Company, as further curtailment of service on the Media-West Chester Branch would cause greater hardship to this community.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
