

MINUTES OF THE 134th MEETING OF THE COUNCIL OF THE BORO. OF CHESTER HEIGHTS, HELD IN THE BORO. SCHOOL BUILDING MONDAY FEB. 3rd 1958 at 8.00 PM

With all members present, the meeting was called to order by President Townsend.

The minutes of the January meeting were read and approved.

The Treasurers report was approved as presented by Miss Dickson.

Report of Road Supervisor and Building Inspector was read by the Secretary.

No other committees reporting.

President Townsend re-appointed the present committees to serve the current term with the following exceptions, Mr. Wood was appointed chairman of the Zoning Committee and Mr, Anderson was appointed chairman of the Building Code committee.

Mr. John F. Cramp was unanimously appointed Borough Solicitor for the term of four years, commencing January 6th.1958.

In reply to the request of Council to the Boro. Solicitor to render an opinion on the legal requirements and procedures necessary for the enforcement of Borough ordinances, Mr. Cramp at this time interpreted sections of the Boro, Code and explained the duties and powers of the Burgess relating to the enforcement of ordinances.

The next order of business was the consideration of the Budget for the year 1958. Mr. Hobough presented the Budget as prepared

by the Financial Committee. It was then moved and seconded and unanimously RESOLVED that the Budget, as presented for the year 1958 is hereby adopted.

The next order of business was the fixing of the Tax Rate for the year 1958.

Upon motion, which was seconded, it was unanimously RESOLVED, that tax ordinance #36, fixing the tax rate in the sum of six mills on each dollar of assessed valuation for general Borough purposes, is hereby adopted.

Mr. Jobson presented the yearly financial and operations report of the Chester Heights Volunteer Fire Company.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
