

MINUTES OF THE 135th MEETING OF THE COUNCIL OF THE BORO. OF CHESTER HEIGHTS HELD IN THE BORO. SCHOOL BUILDING MONDAY MARCH 3rd 1958 at 8.00 PM

The Treasurers report was approved as presented by Miss Dickson.

There were no reports rendered by the various committees.

Mr. Wood advised that he would collect as much information as possible from the National Board of Fire Underwriters and other organizations that would assist the Committee on the revision of the Building Code.

In accordance with the provisions of Act 655 and to complete the Highway Aid Budget for 1958, it was moved and seconded, and unanimously approved that the sum of \$100.00 be transferred from the unappropriated balance of the General Fund to Highway maintenance.

Reports of robberies and house-breaking have been called to the attention of the State Police who have promised more frequent patrols of Borough roads and checking of private driveways.

Mr. Wood suggested that the Highway Committee consider a plan or set-up whereby snow removal ^{service} could be provided or be available if and when required.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
