

MINUTES OF THE 138th MEETING OF THE COUNCIL OF THE BORO. OF CHESTER HEIGHTS HELD IN THE BORO. SCHOOL BUILDING MONDAY JUNE 2nd 1958 at 8.00 PM

The meeting was called to order by President Townsend with all members present excepting Mr. Hobough.

Building Inspector; Mr. Voigt reported he had again investigated a complaint on the burning of trash by the Crystal X Corp. and the Aldon Rug Mills. This was referred to the Burgess for further handling. The Aldon Rug Mills stated they own ground within the Boro. limits, therefore claim they are permitted to burn their trash on this ground. As this property does not appear on the Borough Tax list, it was moved and seconded and unanimously approved that the Secretary communicate with the Tax Assessor to investigate and if possible to place this property on the Boro. Assessment list for tax purposes.

Mr. Wood requested the Highway Committee to furnish a report at the July meeting as to what has been done to have the Highway Dept. clean and repair WaWa Road.

New Business;

Mr. Chester Anderson presented his resignation as a member of Council. As Mr. Anderson is moving from the State, this resignation was accepted with regrets. Mr. Townsend requested members of Council to consider a replacement for Mr. Anderson by the next meeting.

In the matter of the closing of WaWa Ticket Office, it was moved and seconded and unanimously agreed that no further action is planned by Council and that the letter of protest that Mr. Buckley stated was sent by the Boro. Solicitor was not authorized by Boro. Council.

The letter from the Penna. Dept. of Highways ordering the removal of the 35 mile speed signs on Valleybrook Road within sixty days was referred to the Committee on Public Safety to file a protest.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
