

MINUTES OF THE 141st MEETING OF THE COUNCIL OF THE BORO. OF CHESTER HEIGHTS HELD IN THE CHESTER HGTS. FIRE CO. BUILDING MONDAY OCT. 6th 1958 at 8 P? M.

The meeting was called to order by President Townsend with all members present.

The minutes of the Sept. meeting were read and approved.

The oath of Office was administered to Mr. L. E. Kerns, Jr., as a member of Council, by J. P. Theo. Buckley.

The Treasurers report was approved as presented by Miss Dickson. Report of Highway Committee; Mr. Samuel Ward reported he had received two proposals for the removal of snow from Boro. roads. Mr. Henry Smedley offered the use of a bull-dozer for a retainer fee of \$100.00 and Mr. Wm. Sweigert a fee of \$150.00. This retainer fee would include the first ten hours of use, Any additional time required would be at the rate of Ten Dollars per hour. A further report concering the terms of a contract will be presented at the November meeting.

It was also reported that the Penna. Highway Dept. had granted a ninety day extention for the retention of the 35 Mile limit on Valleybrook road.

New Business; Dr. Wm. Fager, President of the Chester Heights School Board offered the School Building to the Borough as a gift, to be used for all Borough purposes. Before accepting this offer, President Townsend appointed the following committee composed of Mr. Hobough, Mr. Ward and Mr. Jobson to consider

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this offer and report at the November meeting.

The Secretary was directed to send a letter of thanks to the Chester Heights Fire for the use of the Fire House for Council meetings.

A letter of resignation from Irwin K. Little as Burgess of the Borough was read and accepted.

In order that further consideration may be given on a candidate to fill the unexpired term of the Burgess, President Townsend declared this meeting would now recess until Monday October 13th. at 8 o'clock P. M.

The recess declared over and the meeting called to order by President Townsend.

Mr. Breneman submitted a further report from the Penna. Highway Dept. in which they advised that the Borough was not entitled to a 35 mile speed limit on Valleybrook Road as the Borough could not properly enforce same.

President Townsend called for nominations for the Office of Burgess and the name of Mr. H. Herbert Breneman was presented. Nominations were declared closed and Mr. Breneman was unanimously appointed to fill the unexpired term of Irwin Little as Burgess of the Borough. This term to expire the first Monday of January 1962. The resignation of Mr. Breneman as a member of Council was presented and accepted,

President Townsend appointed the following committee to consider a candidate to fill the vacancy on Council;

Mr. Hobaugh, Mr. Jobson and Mr. Ward.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
