

MINUTES OF THE 142nd MEETING OF THE COUNCIL OF THE BORO. OF CHESTER HEIGHTS HELD IN THE CHESTER HEIGHTS FIREHOUSE MONDAY NOV. 3rd 1958 at 8.00PM

The meeting was called to order by President Townsend, with all members present excepting Mr. Jobson and Mr. Wood.

The minutes of the October meeting were read and approved, with correction noted. (regarding enforcement of 35 mile limit)

The following receipts were reported and handed to the Treas.,

Dela. Co. Treas. 1956 taxes	1.49
Mrs. Jobson 1958 taxes	190.30

The following bills were approved and ordered paid;

John S. Voigt labor on Hwys.	25.00
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The Treasurers report was approved as presented by Miss Dickson.

Report of Burgess; Mr. Breneman reported the removal of

illegal real estate signs from several properties in the Boro.

The complaint of Mr. G. W. K Voigt concerning the operations of

the Gulflyte Co. was investigated and this Company was advised

to apply to the Zoning Board of Adjustment for a special exception

to operate according to Boro. Ordinances. Mr. Breneman reported

that considerable property damage was done in the Boro. on

Halloween night and suggested that in the future Special Deputies

be appointed to patrol the Boro. to prevent a recurrence of this

type of vandalism.

Highway Committee reported a number of highway signs were in bad

condition and would be re-painted, and repaired.

Building Code Committee; Mr. Ward reported that <sup>the first seven sects.</sup> ~~the~~ ~~of~~ ~~revised~~

ordinance was in the process of being typed and would then be

submitted to the Solicitor for approval.

At this time President Townsend called for nominations to fill

the vacancy on Council created by the resignation of Mr. Breneman.

The name of Mr. C. N. Smitheman Jr. was presented and nominations

declared closed. Mr. Smitheman was unanimously appointed to serve

the unexpired term of Mr. Breneman as a member of Council.

This term expires on the first Monday of Jan. 1960.

Unfinished business;

Mr. Hobaugh, reporting for the Special Committee which was appointed to consider the offer of the School Board to turn the School Building over to the Borough, recommended that this offer be accepted, that the building be boarded up for the present time and that a permanent committee be appointed to consider the future use of the building. It was then moved, seconded and unanimously approved that the Borough accept title to the Chester Heights School Building as per the verbal request of Dr. Wm. Fager, President of the Chester Heights School Board. The Secretary was directed to so advise the School Board.

Upon motion, which was seconded, it was unanimously approved that the sum of \$1000.00, representing the balance due on the \$1500.00 appropriation be paid to the Chester Heights Fire Co. at this time. The matter of snow removal from Boro, roads was further discussed. It was moved and seconded and unanimously approved that the Highway Committee is hereby authorized to negotiate a contract with Henry Smedley covering standby arrangements for a bulldozer for snow removal and cindering of highways, when and if needed.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
