

MINUTES OF THE 143rd MEETING OF THE COUNCIL OF THE BORO. OF CHESTER HEIGHTS
HELD IN THE CHESTER HEIGHTS FIREHOUSE MONDAY Dec. 1st 1958 at 8.00 P. M.

Report of Committees;

Building Inspector John Voigt advised he had received request for permit and plans for new home from Mr. McManus and requested members of Council to inspect the plans before the issuance of permit.

Highway Committee presented contract of Henry Smedley for snow removal and cindering of Boro. roads for the period of Nov. 15th 1958 to May 15th 1959.

It was moved and seconded and unanimously approved that this contract as presented is hereby accepted and that a retainer fee of \$100.00 covering first priority service for HD-5 Dozer be paid at this time.

President Townsend made the following committee appointments, Mr. C. N. Smitheman and Mr. L. E. Kerns to the Public Safety Committee with Mr. Jobson designated as Chairman.

Committee.

Communication from Mr. Wm. Fager, President of Chester Heights School District, was read. Mr. Fager stated that it was not the intention of the School Board to transfer title of the School Building to the Borough as previously reported. The Secretary was directed to advise Mr. Fager that Borough Council was not interested in the operation of the Building for Borough purposes at this time.
